Re: Notice of Planned Decisional Classification for "Western EIM sub-entity scheduling coordinator role"

## Any objection by the Chairs to this decisional classification is due by August 24, 2021.

This is formal notice of ISO Management's decisional classification for the "Western EIM subentity scheduling coordinator role" initiative. Any objection by the Chairs to the decisional classification is due by August 24, 2021. Otherwise, this initiative will be presented for decision consistent with the classification described below. ${ }^{1}$

This initiative falls within the EIM Governing Body's primary authority (E1) for two independent reasons. First, the proposed rules to create a new type of scheduling coordinator role would be ElM-specific, because it would be available only to market participants within the balancing authority areas of EIM entities and not across the entire market footprint. Second, the primary driver for addressing this topic is to resolve an issue that was initiated by one EIM balancing authority area.

The decisional classification for this initiative has not been addressed previously in any briefing to the EIM Governing Body. The final proposal for this initiative is located here. Additional relevant papers for this initiative are located here.

Written stakeholder comments on the final proposal, including the proposed classification, were due on May 26, 2021. There were no objections to the decisional classification in the final proposal.
