Re: Notice of Planned Decisional Classification for the Change to Flexible Ramping Product Refinements Initiative

Any objection by the Chairs to this decisional classification is due by July 11, 2022

This is formal notice of Management's decisional classification for the *Change to Flexible Ramping Products Refinements* initiative. The change proposed in the May 18, 2022 paper consists of not reducing economic WEIM energy transfers to zero when a balancing authority area fails the WEIM's resource sufficiency evaluation.

Any objection by the Chairs to the decisional classification is due by July 11, 2022. Otherwise, this initiative will be presented for decision consistent with the classification described below.¹

The proposed change falls within the joint authority of the WEIM Governing Body and the Board of Governors, because the tariff rules would be applicable to WEIM participants in their capacity as participants in the WEIM. None of the proposed tariff rules would be applicable "only to the CAISO balancing authority area or to the CAISO-controlled grid."
