**Re:** Notice of Planned Decisional Classification for “2023 Interconnection Process Enhancements Track 1”

---

***Any objection by the Chairs to this decisional classification is due by May 8, 2023.***

This is formal notice of Management’s decisional classification for “2023 Interconnection Process Enhancements Track 1.” Management believes that this item will require the approval only of the ISO Board of Governors and that the WEIM Governing Body will have no role in the decision. This initiative focuses on adjustments needed to the schedule for processing and studying Cluster 15 interconnection requests.

Any objection by the Chairs to this decisional classification is due by Monday, May 8, 2023. Otherwise, the initiative will be presented for decision consistent with this classification.<sup>1</sup>

The advisory role of the WEIM Governing Body extends to any proposal to change or establish tariff rules that would apply to the real-time market but are not within the scope of joint authority. This initiative, however, does not propose changes to real-time market rules and therefore the WEIM Governing Body does not have a role in the decision.

Written stakeholder comments on the final proposal were due April 24, 2023. No commenter objected that the proposed classification is incorrect under the currently effective rules.
