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#### Recap of February 8 WRA proposal

- WRA proposed a new west-wide GHG accounting system that expands WREGIS's REC program to cover renewable, clean/non-emitting, and emitting resources
- This system could be leveraged by state regulators in their administration of RPS/CES/GHG programs
- If such a system were built, it would require:
  - An entity to develop and operate a system that attributes generation to load
  - A methodology for creating all-generation certificates that also tracks the attributes of this generation
  - West-wide cooperation and agreement on data req'ts



#### This working group's role related to this proposal

- Most of these activities are outside of CAISO's control or traditional role
- However, there a few questions that this working group could consider:
  - Do we want the CAISO to build/operate this system?
  - If not, do we want an EDAM to provide data to such a program once it is developed?
  - If we want EDAM to provide the data, do we want to build reporting requirements into the market optimization design?



#### Data reporting impacts on GHG market optimization

- How could the EDAM GHG market optimization design be impacted by the data reporting requirements?
  - Such a system might require resource-specific attribution of generation to load which might be incompatible with unspecified approach
  - West-wide GHG tracking system might not be completed by January 2024 (expected EDAM go-live)
- These impacts might constrain how we design the EDAM GHG market optimization
- Even if a constraint isn't imposed, an extra layer of complexity is added onto an already complicated topic



### Options for how to proceed on carbon reporting

Option	Means	Implemented by:

3) EDAM GHG market design is independent from but might not allow for GHG reporting system	<ul> <li>Once a new west-wide GHG accounting is developed, CAISO provides certain data for its operation</li> <li>WG not constrained by data requirements of a hypothetical west-wide GHG accounting system</li> </ul>	<ul><li>State regulators/ policy-makers</li><li>WREGIS</li></ul>
