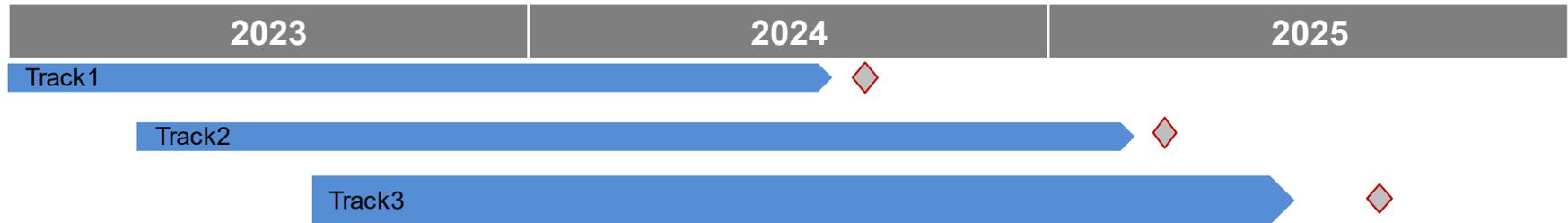

FERC 881 Project Timelines by Tracks



- **Track 1 – Real Time Reliability Applications**
 - Delays in application deliver timeline with FAC-11 additions to the project.
 - Utilization of AAR in real time reliability applications.
 - Estimated - Target Capability to be ready by Q3 2024 . Originally Q2.
- **Track 2 – Operational/EMS Model Data and Applications**
 - OATI Webliner product will be utilized for receiving Look ahead ratings.
 - Finalizing OATI functional specification document.
 - Estimated - Target Capability to be ready early 2025
- **Track 3 – Market Application and Look Ahead Applications**
 - Requirements phase started and should be complete by September 2024.
 - Based on requirements gathering and vendor/internal resources constraints potential for delay in some aspects of implementation.
 - Estimated - Target Capability to be ready in Q2 2025.

Data submission work progress.

- ISO uploaded template filled with TOP/BAA model data from DB129(latest) model delivered on production July 10th 2024.

- So far multiple BAA/IOU had one on one meeting with ISO SME and resolved most of the clarifying questions regarding how to fill out the template.
- Few entity are close to filling out ICCP ID, duration, reasonability limits based on their model by Q4 2024
- ISO will update template twice this year.
- Last update in 2024 will be from DB-132(M12). Model will go live week of 12/16/2024
- ISO will start to update template after each model build next year in preparation of go live in July 12th 2025. Data submission process will align with normal model update process via RIMS.
- ISO EMS software upgrade will be done by early Q4 2024. Testing will start early 2025

OATI webLineR:

- CAISO and OATI is finalizing webLineR functional specification.
- webLineR tool will be the main Ambient Adjusted Rating and Seasonal rating management system for RCWEST TOP's.
- For CAISO PTO's current transmission registry will be primary interface for managing seasonal ratings and webLineR for managing Ambient Adjusted ratings.
 - The plan is to move PTO's seasonal rating management into webLineR as part of a future project.

OATI WebLineR:

- webLineR will construct the facility model by extracting relevant objects from a CIM file provided by the CAISO Enterprise Model Management System (EMMS).
- webLineR will support seasonal ratings and Dynamic ratings.

OATI Webliner:

- webLineR will perform seasonal rating validation.
 - Reasonability range test
 - Rate of change test
 - Missing rating type test
 - Ascending rating type order test
- Participants will manage their seasonal ratings in webLineR via UI, CSV upload or API import. All changes in active ratings will be immediately transmitted to the downstream CAISO systems.

OATI WebLineR:

- webLineR submission API will enable TO participants to comply with the FERC order and submit AAR.
 - AAR submitted by participants will be validated.
- In addition to providing the forecasted ratings, AAR can be used to supply the real time ratings to webLineR. Participant can place the real time rating value into the current hour slot.
- webLineR will support one normal rating and up to 4 emergency ratings.

OATI WebLineR:

- All AAR will be retained in webLineR for a period of 5 years, in accordance with the FERC Order 881 requirements
 - Will be available for viewing on User Interface displays and can be downloaded via query API.
- webLineR will perform the ratings coordination (or ratings clearing) for tie-lines, where TO participants at each end can independently submit their own ratings.
 - webLineR will select the most restrictive (smallest) rating value in each time period as the cleared dynamic rating that will be transmitted.
