## **SUMMARY OF CHANGES**



## BPM changes so RUC exports do not have higher priority than load in <u>HASP</u>

- Current
  - Load = \$1450
  - PT Export from RUC = \$1500
  - LPT Export from RUC = \$1500
  - Export leg of wheel from RUC = \$1500
- Proposal
  - Load = \$1450
  - PT Export from RUC = \$1450
  - Export leg of PT wheel from RUC = \$1450
  - LPT Export from RUC = \$1150
  - Export leg of LPT wheel from RUC = \$1150



# Create two categories of wheels to differentiate import leg scheduling priority

- Current
  - All self-scheduled wheel import leg equal to selfscheduled import
- Proposal
  - LPT wheel import leg set to \$0
  - Economic wheel cannot bid import leg below \$0
  - PT wheel import leg equal to self-scheduled import



# Establish criteria for high priority wheels whose import leg is equivalent to self-scheduled import

- Current
  - No criteria
- Proposal
  - Signed contract to serve load in another BAA prior to FERC filing date of these proposed changes
  - Procured monthly firm transmission externally to reach boundary of CAISO BAA for the hours of delivery in signed contract
  - Must notify CAISO 45 days prior to the month of the MW quantity and verify transmission purchase
  - Will register export system resource in market prior to start of month



#### Additional clarifications

- Notification for high priority wheels
  - For July and August, PT wheel showing must be made June 29
- Post-HASP allocation process
  - Eliminate greater of RUC awards from pro-rata allocation
- Sunset date for wheel through proposal
  - May 31<sup>st</sup> sunset date, since eliminated filing cut off date
  - After sunset, all self-schedule wheel export leg equal to load, all self-schedule wheel import leg equal to self-schedule import. Remove post HASP process from tariff.



New: Clarify process for SC to accurately communicate de-rate/outage between RA capacity and non-RA capacity

- SC to notify CAISO of the reduction in RA capacity from de-rate/outage if the resource is also a designated resource to support PT exports
- For forced outage, until SC notifies CAISO, if the designated flag in Master File is Yes, distribute pro-rata between RA capacity and remaining capacity up to PMax
