Background

- Resource Adequacy Modeling and Program Design Track 3A: Resource Visibility policy initiative
- The ISO would like to get insight into the contractual status of its fleet of resources
- This request is an interim measure for this summer
 - June to September of 2025
- Full implementation and with automation (most likely in CIRA) is planned to go with the policy initiative process targeting next summer

The Request

- The California ISO is requesting Scheduling Coordinators (SCs) for generating resources to provide contractual data for their resources for this summer
- Resources that are on the NQC list and anticipate being on the NQC list during this summer
- This is a one-time submission for this summer (June to September of 2025)
- Please submit the data by June 25, 2025

The Categories Requested

- **Contracted to the ISO BAA LSE:** This refers to RA-eligible capacity under a capacity contract to an ISO BAA LSE for the months of June to September of 2025. This applies regardless of how the resource has been, or is planned to be, shown to the ISO on monthly RA supply plans for the months in question.
- **Sold outside the ISO BAA:** This refers to RA-eligible capacity that is under a capacity contract outside of the ISO BAA for the months of June to September of 2025.
- **Not contracted:** This refers to RA-eligible capacity that does not fit into either of the above categories

California ISO Balancing Authority Area (BAA)

- This request is only for resources that are inside the CAISO BAA (i.e. NQC eligible)
- Is if the capacity is sold to load inside the CAISO BAA or outside it?
- Or not under contract?



How to Submit the Data

- Submit via a CIDI ticket with the subject line of **“2025 Summer Visibility Data Request”**
- Fill the “CAISO Resource Visibility Template” posted on the CAISO website under Generation and transmission then Resource adequacy
- Please submit the data by June 25, 2025
- Please contact us if you need more time to prepare the data and submit it
