Scope Items Discussed: Transfer revenue distribution

Presenters: James Lynn – CAISO

Discussion:

The objective of this meeting was to review OATT and non-OATT rights as well as transmission revenue distribution from a settlements perspective for transfers between EDAM BAAs.

The ISO is working on putting together a series of examples regarding OATT and non-OATT rights across multiple BAAs, as well as imports from or exports out of EDAM BAAs to non-participating EDAM BAAs. Today the discussion will focus on congestion rent compensation framework for Bucket 2 transfer transmission.

James Lynn, the Senior Advisor from the CAISO market settlements design team, walked the stakeholders through a discussion around EDAM transfers. James' presentation, as well as the examples he covered are available on the working group website. The presentation included the following:

- What is an EDAM transfer
- Transfer to vs. transfer through
- What is transfer revenue
- Examples from workbook

James shared an excel workbook with multiple examples on transfer revenue. Stakeholders were able to ask clarifying questions. The workbook is posted on the EDAM webpage for work group #2 and stakeholders are encouraged to download and look over.

Conclusion:

James' presentation and workbook generated a lot of questions. Some topics still need to be discussed at more length and James will cover the rest of the transfer revenue examples at the next meeting.
